Sarasota County will receive \$210 million in Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery funds to support the long-term recovery efforts from 2024 storms Debby, Helene and Milton.

Help us learn about the community's unmet needs and develop a public action plan to distribute these funds!

In February 2025, Sarasota County will hold four public meetings to hear from the community about their unmet needs and collect feedback on projects or programs the community thinks would be most beneficial to support disaster recovery. Funds can be used for restoration of infrastructure (roads, bridges, stormwater, etc.), housing, economic revitalization and mitigation, with a primary focus on assisting low- to moderate-income households.
